What is Litigation Finance?

Litigation finance is a specialized asset-backed lending strategy that provides capital to plaintiffs, law firms, or legal entities in exchange for a share of potential case proceeds. The financing supports legal expenses, working capital, and trial-related costs and is typically repaid only upon a successful settlement or judgment. Returns are uncorrelated to traditional markets and depend primarily on legal outcomes and case-specific dynamics.

Why invest?

- Non-correlated returns: Outcomes are driven by legal judgments, not public market movements.
- **High yield potential:** Legal claims, especially commercial or intellectual property cases, may generate substantial risk-adjusted returns.
- **Diversified exposure:** Strategies include portfolios of cases across sectors, geographies, and claim types.
- Structured risk mitigation: Fund managers often invest across multiple legal matters to balance outcome variability.

Risks to consider

- Case outcome uncertainty: Repayment is contingent on favorable legal resolution.
